




TOP 5 GENRES PUBLISHED (2021)

Grant for the Publication of Taiwanese Works in Translation (GPT)

GPT is set up by the Ministry of Culture to encourage the publication of Taiwanese works in translation overseas, to raise the international visibility of Taiwanese cultural content, and to help Taiwan's publishing industry expand into non-Chinese international markets. Applications are usually accepted during two periods: April 1 through April 30, and October 1 through October 31.

Yi-Hsum Chang

張亦絢

Born in 1973 in Taipei, Chang earned a Master's degree from the Department of Cinema and Audiovisual Studies at Paris III Sorbonne Nouvelle. She began to sell stories when she was a high school student. In 2012, Chang was listed in "the 20 best Sinophone writers under 40" by *Unitas Magazine*. Chang was a writer-in-residence at Taipei National University of the Arts in 2019. Now she is also a director and screenwriter.

In 1996, *Domestic Affairs* was awarded *Unitas's* New Author Award for Fiction, winning high praise from the judging panel. It was also selected for *Avanguard's* The Best Taiwanese Literature 1995-1996. Selected stories from Chang's short story collections *When Things Decay* and *The Best of Times* are being taught in Queer Studies classes in universities. In 2012, her novel *Not in Love for Long: Recollections of Nantes and Paris* was nominated for TIBE Book Prize. Her major work, *I'm Leaving*, showed a transgressive and intimate portrait of a contemporary Taiwanese. *Herstory of Sex*, winner of many literary awards in Taiwan, contains four short stories, "Forty-three Floors," "Illicit Desire," "History of Sexual Meaning," and "A Whore Wasn't Made in a Day."

Domestic Affairs is a novel selected for the NMTL Literature in Translation Japanese Project that has now been published in Japanese. The article "Domestic Affairs wasn't built in a day" was published in *Taiwan Literature: English Translation Series*, no. 49. *I'm Leaving* earned the 2021 "21st Century Ascendant" Award, an annual honor established by Wenhsun Publishing in 1970 to recognize each year's most influential new novels. Taiwan literary researcher Ma Yi-hang wrote in his article "Contemporary novels: Settings and Transgressions" that: "While its structure of politics, gender, and memories allows *I'm Leaving* to capture the essence of the contemporary novel, its form and plot radically work to oppose and destroy all pretense of such an inheritance or lineage. The juxtaposition of inheritance and separation parallels the violence and mediocrity distributed amongst various positions in contemporary identity politics."

Po-Ching Chen

陳栢青



Novelist Po-Ching Chen, born in 1983, earned his master's degree from National Taiwan University (NTU)'s Graduate Institute of Taiwan Literature. In 2012, he was named one of Taiwan's "Most-promising novelists under 40" by the literary journal *Unitas*. His published works include novels *The Rubber Chicken Club* and *Small City* and the essay compilation *Mr. Adults*.

His unique and creative style weaves elements of science fiction and horror into traditional literary forms, and he is adept at using subcultures to subvert and ultimately trounce mainstream cultural mores under the principle that destruction is a necessary precursor to construction. Reflecting the author's experience growing up gay in 1990s Taiwan, a warm, simple innocence glows just beneath the surface of his sensationalist subject matter. While his words may be satirically barbed, his underlying narratives convey a keen sense of sadness. Po-Ching deftly escapes the purely "performative" nature of creative literature by blurring the lines between the "performance" and the private time after the curtain has been drawn and made-up faces revert to normal.




